
ORDER


1. This is an Appeal under Section 5-C of the Cinematograph Act, 1952 (37 of 1952) filed by Mr. Sanjay Niranjan, Producer. The Appeal is within time.

2. We have heard Mr. Sanjay Niranjan who is Producer of the film and is also representing the appellant. Shri Rajkumar, Regional Officer, is also present on behalf of the Central Board of Film Certification (CBFC), Mumbai. We have viewed the film and we have discussed the various cuts/excisions with both the parties and as a result of the discussion, it has been agreed by both parties as under:-

- (i) At 1hr15min35sec the word 'Mohammed' should be deleted or muted.
- (ii) At 1hr31min30sec the word 'Kaaafir' should be deleted or muted..
- (iii) From 1hr29min39sec to 1hr30min gesture and clapping scenes should be deleted..
- (iv) At 1hr48min the word 'Suuar' should be deleted or muted.

3. In view of the above cuts/deletions agreed to be made in the film, the Film Certification Appellate Tribunal hereby certifies the film as 'U'. The order has been announced to the parties and can be implemented. After the necessary compliance is carried out, the film may be permitted to be released by CBFC. Parties to be informed accordingly.
